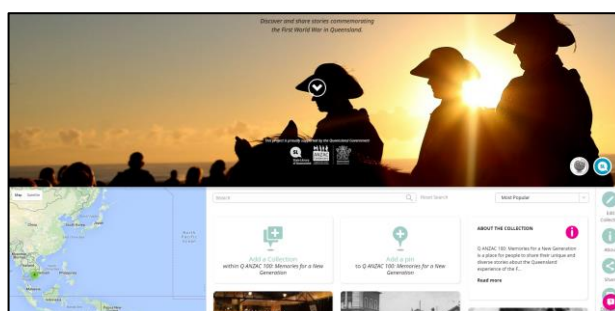

We invite you to explore and to contribute your own story.

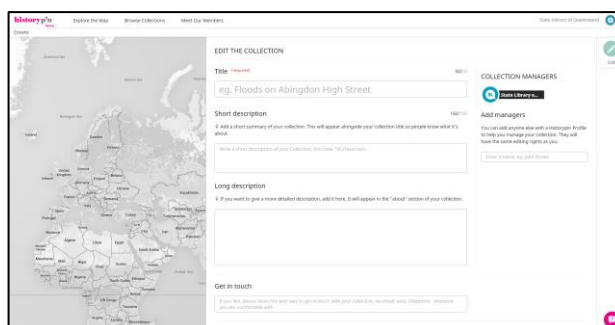
Creating content

1. To create your own collection, you'll first need to create a Historypin profile. You can do this using your **Facebook** account, **Twitter** account, **Google** account, or your **email address**.

2. Once you've created your profile, you can add your content (photos, video or audio) by going to the Q ANZAC 100 Historypin hub at <https://www.historypin.org/en/first-world-war-centenary/memories-for-a-new-generation/> and selecting **Add a Collection**.



3. Follow the prompts, including a Title, short description, long description, contact details, location and image for your collection. Click **Save** at the bottom of the page. You can go back and edit these details at any time.



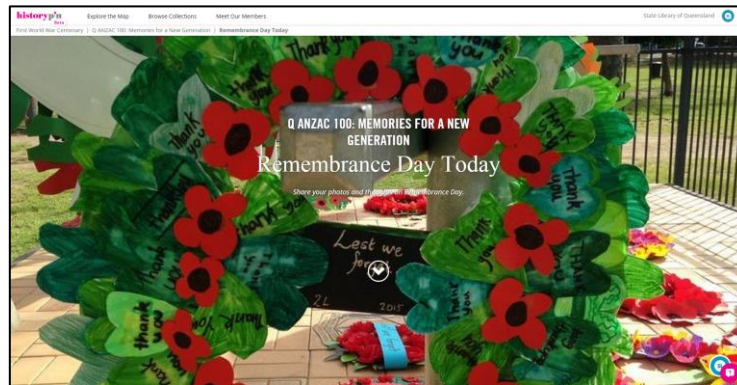
Adding content

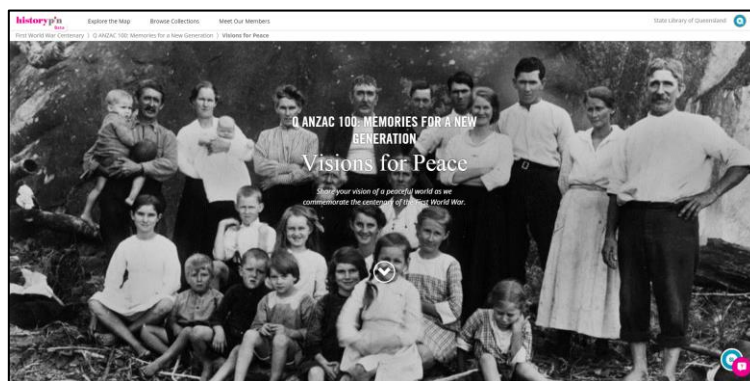
