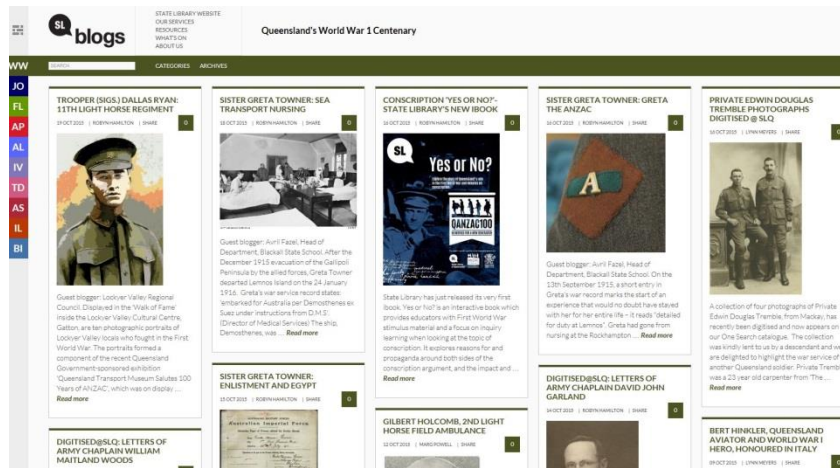




# WWI CENTENARY BLOG
